**WWMF 100 Rules Tariff**

Item 0220      Overflow Shipments

Section 01

Effective Jan/01/08

Except as otherwise provided, when the applicable minimum weight for any rate herein or in tariffs governed hereby cannot be loaded into, or on, a vehicle of not less than 53 feet in length, or when a shipment in excess of such minimum weight cannot be loaded into, or on, a vehicle of not less than 53 feet in length, the shipment shall be charged for as follows:

1. Except as otherwise provided for in paragraph 2, the charge for each vehicle loaded (See Note A) will be charged for at the actual weight loaded into vehicle or the minimum weight specified, whichever is greater, at the applicable rate.
2. When more than one fully loaded vehicle is required for the transportation of a single shipment, the portion of the shipment on the last vehicle loaded will be rated as a separate shipment, at the applicable rate.

NOTE A: A vehicle will be considered to be loaded to capacity when:

1. The vehicle is loaded to its legal weight limit in the origin or destination State, or any State through which it must traverse.
  2. No more of the same kind of freight tendered in the shipment, and in the shipping form tendered, can be loaded into, or on, the vehicle.
